JOB ANNOUNCEMENT ORGANIZER (WASHINGTON, D.C. AREA)

The Reproaction Education Fund leads bold action to increase access to abortion and advance reproductive justice. We are a left-flank culture change organization with deep chops in strategic communications, fearless opposition research, and community organizing, including but not limited to non-violent direct action. We are committed to racial justice. And, we're growing!

POSITION DESCRIPTION

The organizer, under the direct supervision of Reproaction's deputy director, will engage in community organizing and direct action, planning and executing in-person and virtual events and outreach. The organizer will cultivate and engage relationships with volunteer grassroots activists, local and national organizations, and coalitions to support this work.

Reproaction is known for deploying innovative campaigns that the organizer shall work on. Through our self-managed abortion with pills campaign, the organizer will share the World Health Organization protocol for safely and effectively ending a pregnancy outside the medical system. Through our #BadFaithMedicine campaign, the organizer will get boots in the street to protest anti-abortion fake clinics. The organizer will also own local demonstrations Reproaction engages in within Washington, D.C.

While Reproaction is an all-virtual organization, this is a geography-specific position requiring that candidates live in or have willingness to relocate to the metropolitan area of Washington, D.C. This is a full-time position.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develop and support offline actions and organizing efforts relevant to Reproaction's core campaigns
- Plan and manage events to educate the public and activists about direct action, abortion access, and reproductive justice
- Facilitate reproductive justice and direct action events and trainings
- Recruit volunteers and develop community leaders
- Develop and manage the execution of community-based grassroots organizing strategies, and systems to connect grassroots activists with resources for cultivating potential partners
- Support media events to draw attention to Reproaction campaigns and assist in working with local media
- Assist with other organizational priorities as required
- Develop online actions, especially drafting email alerts targeting Reproaction supporters and creating social content
- Support activists working on Reproaction campaigns
- Collaborate with Reproaction team on campaign strategy and tactics

- Work directly with local organizations and coalitions to get their members involved in Reproaction's core campaigns
- Garner grassroots support for abortion access and reproductive justice by mobilizing supporters and the greater public
- Manage the collection of data from actions, events and trainings
- Manage volunteers and online activists in database and online platforms
- Collaborate with appropriate Reproaction staff on data hygiene and regular communications to activists, and other duties, as relevant and assigned

QUALIFICATIONS

- Experience with activism or campaigns, either in a paid capacity or as a volunteer
- Demonstrated ability to engage the grassroots, and speak and write compellingly
- Flexible, self-starter, and multi-tasker
- Discretion and judgement, including strong discernment skills and ability to hold confidential information at close hold
- Strong research, online writing, critical analysis and editing skills, and a commitment to getting it right
- Proficiency in social media, ability to make informational graphics
- Initiative and ability to self-motivate in an all-virtual, start-up organization
- Ability to work with urgency and under pressure while remaining calm, organized, and professional
- Accountability, a commitment to professionalism and open communication, and receptiveness to performance-based direction
- Adaptability and an entrepreneurial spirit; comfort with creativity and experimentation

REQUIREMENTS

- Fierce and firm commitment to reproductive justice, including but not limited to abortion rights without exceptions
- Ability to work without in-person supervision in a home office or other self-chosen professional environment with Internet access and minimal background noise
- Ability to work some evening and weekend hours in support of volunteer activists
- Ability to travel on occasion
- Strong interpersonal skills, especially the ability to work with diverse groups and willingness to consider alternative points of view

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

This is a professional position (0-2 years relevant paid experience). Salary is \$55,000 and includes benefits, with opportunity for growth based on performance.

The Reproaction Education Fund is a fiscally sponsored project of NEO Philanthropy, a 501(c)3 organization. Through NEO Philanthropy, this position is offered a full benefits package, including 100% medical coverage for the employee and 90% medical coverage for dependents; 100% coverage for vision, dental, life/AD&D, long-term disability.
