POSITION DESCRIPTION

Reproaction is looking to hire an executive support fellow in the Northern Virginia/D.C. area to assist our co-director. Tasks may include administrative support, research, communications, participating in direct actions, and any other tasks associated with supporting our co-director as she leads administrative, executive, and operations functions for the organization. This is a part-time, temporary position reporting to and working closely with Reproaction's co-director.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Staffing and supporting locally based co-director, including but not limited to administrative duties, such as submitting proposals, managing receipts and drafting expense reports, booking travel and purchasing equipment, and printing materials
- Assisting with communications, including but not limited to reviewing emails, drafting content for social media or email, scheduling webinars, working with software platforms, and media outreach and scheduling
- Participating in direct actions that fit into Reproaction's strategic objectives under the guidance of Reproaction's co-director
- Executing direct actions, including preparing material, documenting actions through photo, video, and audio collection, and assisting with the debrief process after direct actions
- Attending select Reproaction team meetings, as available and assigned
- Additional duties as assigned, including but not limited to campaigns, opposition research, or event planning

QUALIFICATIONS

- Excellent interpersonal skills, attention to detail, experience with public speaking, and a commitment to getting it right
- Proficiency in social media, specifically during events
- Experience with direct action activism or campaigns, either in a paid capacity or as a volunteer
- Initiative and ability to self-motivate in an all-virtual, startup organization
- Ability to work with urgency and under pressure while remaining calm, organized, and professional
- Accountability and receptiveness to performance-based direction
- Adaptability and an entrepreneurial spirit; comfort with creativity and experimentation
- College degree in progress preferred, although education and professional experience flexible for the right candidate

REQUIREMENTS

- Fierce and firm commitment to reproductive justice, including but not limited to abortion rights without exceptions
- Ability to work without supervision in a home office or other self-chosen professional environment with Internet access and minimal background noise
- Ability to work some evening and weekend hours as required by actions or events
- Strong interpersonal skills, especially the ability to work with diverse people

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

This is an intern/fellow-level position that is best for someone who demands more and better for our movement. Work will be performed remotely and/or in the co-director's home office in Northern Virginia. Pay is \$15/hour without benefits, and the position will be 8 hours per week, with schedule to be set jointly by fellow and supervisor. This position will run September 9 – October 31, 2019.
