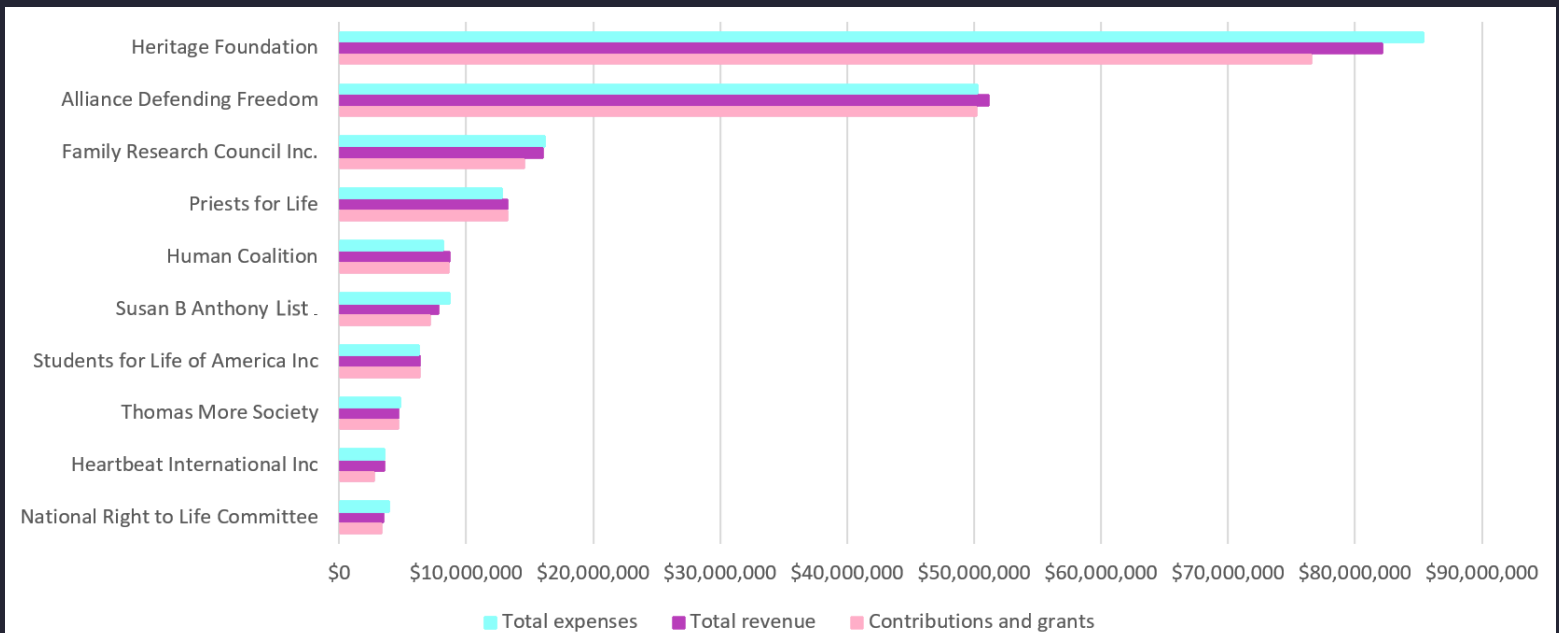


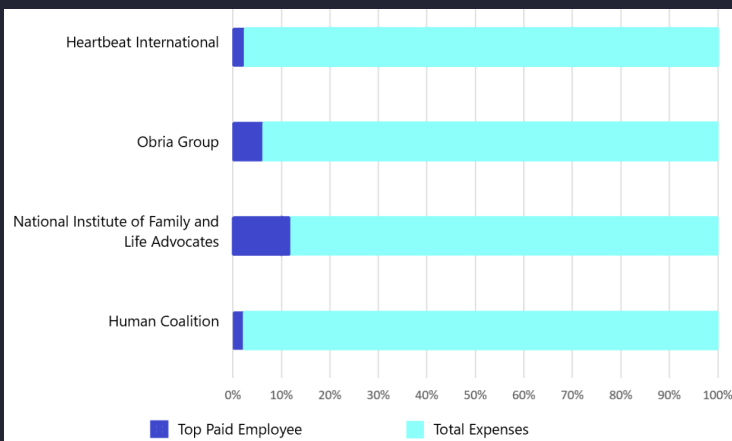
FINANCIAL DATA: ANTI-ABORTION ORGANIZATIONS IN 2016

Many anti-abortion groups claim to be poorly funded, and they have been vying for taxpayer dollars to spread their sex stigma, misogyny, and junk science. Below is the financial data of major "pro-life" groups from the last presidential election year. With one anti-abortion organization planning to spend upwards of \$41 million re-electing Trump and his anti-choice friends, we're asking what groups like theirs are doing with their millions, some from public sources:
