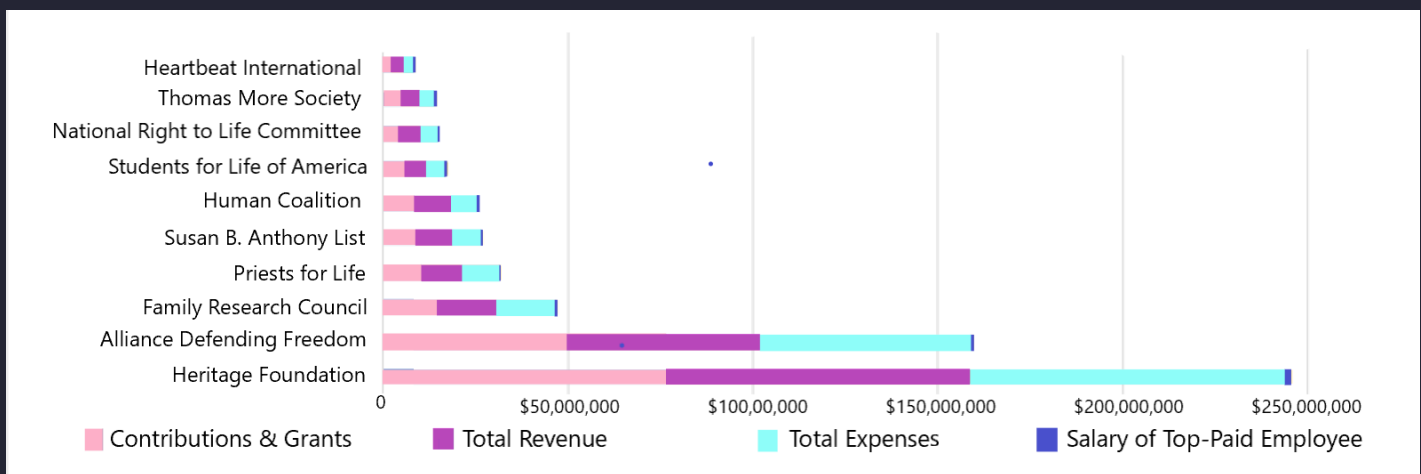


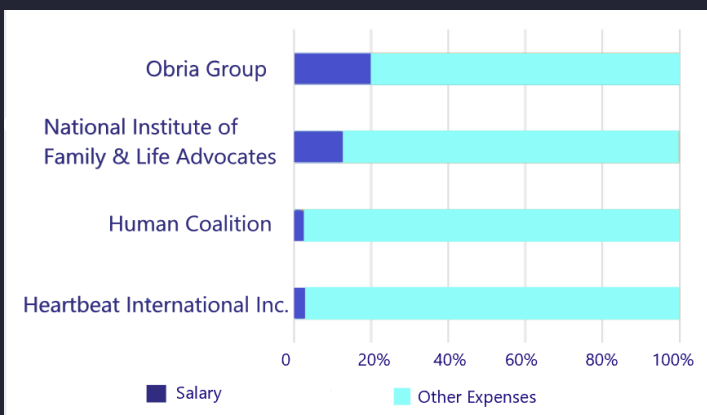
THE BIG MONEY BEHIND BIG "PRO-LIFE"

Many anti-abortion groups claim to be poorly funded, and they have been vying for taxpayer dollars to spread their sex stigma, misogyny, and junk science. Below is the financial data of major "pro-life" groups from the last presidential election year. With one anti-abortion organization planning to spend upwards of \$41 million re-electing Trump and his anti-choice friends, we're asking why these groups should get any public money.

All Told, that's \$193,693,455 total contributions and grants, \$206,255,694 in revenues, \$213,668,525 total expenses, and \$3,649,561 in salaries to CEOs of just this small selection of the thousands of anti-abortion organizations nationwide.
